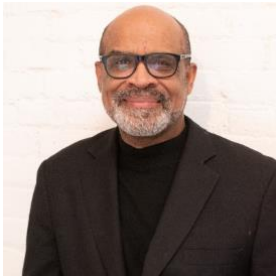
**Zonta Club of Morristown Area’s Virtual March Meeting – the Public is invited to attend.**
